Children's is the largest non-governmental provider of pediatric care in DC.

Children's school nurses provide care in 177 DC public schools (DCPS).

FY 2006 DC Patient Statistics

- Total Hospital Admissions: 12,767
- Total DC Admissions: 3,466
- 27% of Children's inpatients come from DC.
- 21% (2,717) of *total* hospital inpatients are DC Medicaid recipients.
- 75% (2,587) of all *DC* hospital inpatients are DC Medicaid recipients.
- Total Emergency Department Visits: 69,178
- DC residents account for 54% (37,423) of Children's Emergency Department visits.
- The average length of stay for DC Medicaid recipients is 5.88 days (Hospital average is 5.65 days).
- Total Hospital Dental Visits: 7,586
- DC residents account for 55% (4,188) of Children's total dental visits.
