FY 2006 Virginia Patient Statistics

- **Total Hospital Admissions: 12,767**
- **Total Virginia Admissions: 1,487**
- **12% of Children's inpatients come from Virginia.**
- **23% of Children's Virginia inpatients are Medicaid recipients.**
- **More than 9,900 Virginia patients visit Children's each year for inpatient, outpatient and emergency services.**
- **The average length of stay for Virginia Medicaid patients is 8.62 days (Hospital average is 5.69).**
- **The Case Mix Index for Virginia Medicaid patients is 2.239, which represents a higher average acuity level than Medicaid patients from DC and Maryland.**
- **Virginia children account for more than 1,700 of Children's annual Emergency Department visits.**
- **Children's Fairfax Outpatient Center handles more than 25,000 visits per year.**
