### Eligibility requirements:

- You must be a US citizen or legal resident
- Your total household income must be at or below 400% of the federal poverty level (FPL). Visit the [NeedyMeds website](#), which lists the current FPL guidelines

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- You cannot have any private prescription coverage, such as an HMO or PPO
- You cannot have or qualify for:
  - Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) prescription benefits
  - Any federal, state, or local program Medicaid. Exceptions include:
    - Patients who are Medicaid eligible who have applied for and been denied Medicaid

### Download and fill out the application

### Gather proof of income

- Make a copy of one of the following items to show your adjusted gross annual household income:
  - 2 most current paycheck stubs or earning statements for all working members of your household
  - Last year's Federal Income Tax Return (1040)
  - Social Security income, pension, and other income statements
  - W-2 or 1099 forms
  - Unemployment benefit statements

### Take the application and proof of income to your health care provider

- Your health care provider must:
  - Complete the "For Health Care Practitioner" section of the application, including "Order information" (subsection D)
  - Sign and date the application
  - Fax the completed application and proof of income to 1-866-441-4190, or mail them to Novo Nordisk Inc., PO Box 370, Somerville, NJ 08876. Faxes must be sent from your health care provider's office

### **Pharmaceutical Company Co-Pay Coupons**

- Co-pay coupon cards can be used by anyone, regardless of income, to reduce your out of pocket costs at the pharmacy. They often can be used for one or two years before you must re-sign up. One catch to using these coupons is that to the costs they cover may not count toward your deductible or out-of-pocket maximum. Also, you may not use these coupons if you have Medicaid, Tricare or other government health insurance.

### **Older formulations of insulin:**

- If you are in immediate need of insulin and have no health insurance coverage and limited funds, it is possible to obtain very affordable older types of insulin over the counter from Walmart.
- This insulin is sold under the ReliOn (70/30 premixed) name and costs \$25 for a 10mL vial. It works differently than newer insulins, so you will need to contact Children's National directly, to dose it correctly.
