

Instructions for Accessing CHEX and

Completing Computer-Based Training (CBT) - if needed

** Please note: Although CHEX is a web-based system, it works best when accessed on a PC. There are often many connectivity problems when working on a MAC.

Go to www.chexweb.com. You will be prompted to log-in. Log-in is case-sensitive.

USERNAME: cnmc##### (please enter the 5 digit ID number assigned to you)

PASSWORD: LAST NAME - ALL CAPS

When you log in, go to "All Cataloged Programs" on the right and scroll down to "Affiliate Graduate Orientation." Click "Register" and follow the directions for completion. Once registered, the program will show up in your "To Do" list on the main page.

Click on your "TO DO" list at the top of the page. You will see "Affiliate Orientation Graduate – Nurses – Clinical." Click on this and it will open the modules you need to complete.

There is no time limit on any test and you may take a test as many times as necessary to pass it. You can leave any module/test at any time as the system will always take you back to where you left off when you sign back in. When finished, go to "Quick Links," then "My Completed Learning" and print out what's been done and scan to me. (Or do a screen shot & email it).

FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO WILL NEED COMPUTER ACCESS:

You will also need to do the program(s) associated with the computer application(s) for which you will need log-in access. (This is not loaded in your "TO DO LIST" as it is student specific). Note: Each module tells you which CHEX assessment (test) you must take when after you finish the training. You will not be granted access without having passed the test.
